A Letter from the President

Dear Friends of Southern Crescent Technical College:

I know I say this every year, but I don't know where the year has gone since I last wrote a letter for the Annual Report. I do know, however, that since that last letter, there have been a vast number of student and faculty successes that have resulted in significant changes to the lives of the citizens in our nine county service area. As you read this report, I invite you to focus your attention to some of those success stories.

Our year has been filled with changes; the new year found us moving into our new Medical Technology Building, which houses all of our allied health programs, as well as several of the supporting courses. If you have not yet had the opportunity to see the new state-of-the-art facility, please contact us for a tour.

Parrish Construction Group has been hard at work this year on our new Henry County facility. This building will mark the significant beginning of our new Henry County Center, and even more importantly, will begin a new chapter in our already robust relationship with Henry County Schools, and especially with their new College and Career Academy, which will be located virtually next door.

The most important component of our college, our people, has also undergone significant change; no fewer than 15 of our long-time faculty and staff retired during the past year, and several others, while not eligible to retire, also reached the successful end of their working careers. Although we have been fortunate to find qualified replacements for our departing friends and colleagues, we will all miss very much the ones who have left. It warms my heart to think of the vast number of lives they all touched and the changes they created in generations of students!



The best changes of all, however, have come in our students. While enrollment statewide last fall semester was down by -3.6%, the SCTC enrollment was up by +7.5% over the prior year. We slipped a little in the spring semester, yet we still outperformed the state average. Statewide, enrollment was down -2.9%, while SCTC only suffered a -1.4% decline. The economy continues to rough up our service area, but we see positive signs, and that should lead to better enrollment over the next year. The incredible changes in people's lives occurs inside our classroom walls as our students receive new and improved job skills and gain enhanced insights and perceptions as well. I couldn't be prouder of our staff and faculty as they "work their magic."

As I always say, we couldn't do what we do unless you help us, so let me once again express how much I sincerely appreciate the good will, support, and friendship we receive from all the communities across our entire service area. It is truly an honor to serve and I hope you enjoy the annual report!

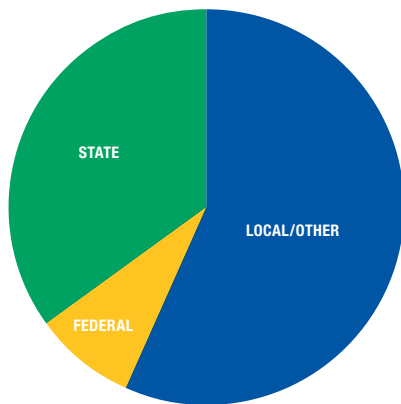

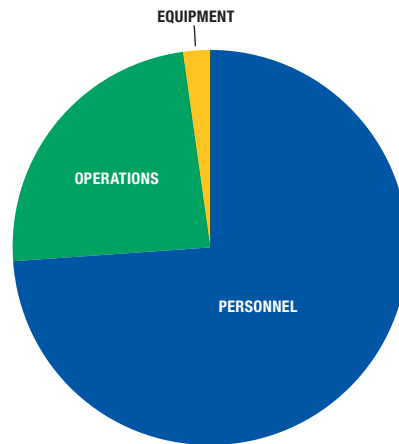

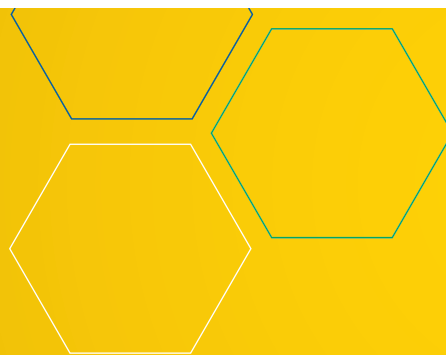
